#### 1. Principal's Sharing

Dear parents and students.

As this school year draws to a close, it has indeed been an extraordinary one. Firstly, Phoenix TV graced us with five to six days of filming at our school, showcasing our unique approach to promoting Confucianism and traditional culture to the nation. In another exciting development, a major domestic TV station has commissioned a Hong Kong media organization to comprehensively introduce the history of our school, set to be broadcast during moments of significant national importance.

3. Good Tidings

This year, we celebrate the milestone 70th anniversary of our school and we marked this momentous occasion with our Speech Day on December 16. It was our honor to have Mr. Kan Wing-ching, the great-grandson of the generous Mr. Kan Hung-chiu, who gifted us the Confucius Hall over nine decades ago, grace the event. The occasion was attended by distinguished guests, such as the president of the Rugby Union, the head of the Police-Community Relations Office, several principals from neighboring schools, and many parents, amplifying the joyous atmosphere.

In the evening, we hosted the 70th Anniversary Gala Dinner and the New School Naming Launch Ceremony at the Maxim's Palace in Sheung Wan with a total of 36 tables. Distinguished guests, including former government officials, renowned professors, artists, school principals, alumni, teachers, students, and parents gathered, making it a truly grand occasion.

A particularly moving moment was Mr. Kan's speech resonating his hopes for the school and the announcement that our fifth graduating class had generously donated a whopping HKD 700,000 to support our economically challenged students and further the school's development. Their benevolence deeply moved both teachers and students. We are brimmed with gratitude for our alumni's affection for their alma mater.

Adding to the evening's significance, Principal Long Shao-ming of our sister school, Sichuan Wenchuan Middle School, led a delegation of senior teachers to the gala dinner. Representatives

from Shishi Middle School in Xiamen also joined us. The fundraising activities that night raised an impressive total of HKD 855,838.

The special publication designed by Ms. Lau Tsz-lok and produced by Mr. Chow Shung-kwan left attendees in awe. The evening was further adorned by the masterful direction of the band by the Music Department Head Mr. Lee Yik-chung. The continuous display of old photos from the past 70 years evoked nostalgia among the attendees.

On January 3, our school won the third prize in the senior secondary category of the 4th Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area Life Education Cultural and Creative (Micro Film) Competition. The project was led by ICT Department Head Mr. Ng Tat-ming, while the principal took to the screen, making a cameo as himself. On January 11, the Hong Kong Arts Development Council's Arts-in-School Partnership Scheme invited Professor Yuen Siu-fai, a renowned artist, to perform Nanyin: Stories of the Past and Present at our school. The event was a resounding success, warmly embraced by our Chinese Classics class, alumni, teachers, and students. Post-performance, our community had the opportunity to share a meal with the performers and discuss future collaborations.

On January 29, we held the opening ceremony of the Chinese Culture Week, which kicked off with a thrilling Shaolin martial arts experience organized by Great China Shaolin Culture. Students even had the opportunity to learn and perform Shaolin boxing on stage.

On February 2, seven primary and secondary schools participated in the Chinese Culture Day. The event featured cultural booth games such as virtual reality cooking experiences, a taste of nostalgic Hong Kong snacks, Spring Festival couplets calligraphy competition, the intricate art of dough figurine making, and sachet crafting. There were also rainbow calligraphy bookmarks, traditional games like pitching pots, archery cooking and oracle bone script matching, quizzes on Chinese musical instruments and Confucian classics. We even had a national security education quiz game! The event attracted nearly a hundred students and teachers from neighboring schools. The event concluded with a professional exchange of insights between the curriculum development officer and teachers from various schools.

On February 3, our school's football team's achievement of reaching the finals was honored as 22 of our teachers and students were invited to witness a friendly match between Inter Miami CF and the Hong Kong Football Team. This exciting match took place at the Hong Kong Stadium.

On February 3, the alumni association gathered for a Poon Choi feast to celebrate the Lunar New Year. This was attended by the school supervisor, school board members, the principal, alumni, Chinese Classics class members, teachers, students, renowned director Lee Lik-chi, Tin Kai-man, and many other cultural figures.

In the realm of student activities, our 2B class student Minsha brilliantly clinched an Excellence Award in the prestigious 26th Hong Kong Youth Science & Technology Innovation Competition with a smart food monitoring box. On April 10, a group of 15 teachers and students from F3B visited the Antarctic research icebreak Xuelong 2. On April 10, two F4 students, under the guidance of the Head of Chemistry Department, attended the Global Conference on Climate



Change at the esteemed Chinese University of Hong Kong, where they engaged in an enlightening live dialogue with scientists stationed on the Xuelong 2 and the Antarctic China Zhongshan Station. Our school was honored to be a part of this dialogue.

From December 1 to 6, as part of our sister school program, a fervent delegation of 15 teachers and students from Jining Confucius School, Shandong visited the Confucius Institute in Qufu and immersed themselves in time-honored rituals, ceremoniously paying respect to teachers, a tradition deeply rooted in our shared philosophy.

They also climbed Mount Tai, the foremost of the revered Five Great Mountains, and toured famous sites including the Baotu Spring, an iconic symbol of Jinan. This exploration has greatly broadened their horizons.

From March 17 to 21, we welcomed a delegation of 30 teachers and students from sister school, Weihai Huancui International Middle School in Shandong. Students from both schools stepped into the same classroom, immersing themselves in the rich tapestry of Chinese cultural traditions. Under the guidance of renowned teachers, they delved into the world of Peking opera and the art of paper cutting.

Besides, they also visited historical sites such as the Guo Yong-huai Memorial Hall, Weihai Folk Culture Village, Museum of the Sino-Japanese War on Liugong Island, and the site of the Jiaodong Wartime Nursery. They also had the opportunity to meet Comrade Liu Yu-bin, the head of the United Front Work Department of Weihai City and exchanged ideas with Weihai municipal officials. This even attracted the attention of Shandong TV to feature our exchange activities in a special broadcast.

From March 29 to April 5, three of our Form 5 students participated in the Hong Kong Youth Ambassador Program, which included a visit to national-level libraries and a tryout with the elite national ice-skating team. This thrilling encounter was truly a new and exciting experience.

On April 10 and 11, the Education Bureau funded a two-day, one-night history and cultural study tour to Guangzhou and Dongguan for a group of 60 Form 5 students and teachers. This tour aimed to deepen their understanding significant historical events and figures that have shaped the magnificent edifice of modern China. It was their first time traveling by high-speed rail, and they visited numerous notable sites such as the Guangdong Memorial Hall of East River Column, the Lin Zexu Memorial Museum, the Guangdong Revolutionary History Museum in Guangzhou, the colonial-style buildings in Shameen, and the trendy Yongqingfang neighborhood. As a thoughtful gesture, the Education Bureau arranged an English-speaking guide to ensure that our non-Chinese speaking students could fully immerse themselves in the cultural experience. The trip successfully painted a vivid picture of the selfless spirit of revolutionaries, the rapid post-pandemic recovery of the nation's economy and people's lives, and the importance of national and military security.

This summer, the school has arranged exchange programs to South Korea, Singapore, and Shanghai, with the Shanghai trip being fully funded. The school stands steadfast in its commitment to expanding the students' worldviews. We are also offering full financial support to



economically disadvantaged students for these exchange activities.

Over the past few years, our students have truly outshone themselves through various competitions and activities. Their accomplishments have garnered public acclaim. Amidst the competitive landscape of student recruitment across Hong Kong, we have seen a heartening and consistent rise in enrollment numbers, a testament to our growing appeal.

Our exchange programs, marked by high-level receptions, not only instill in our students a sense of confidence but also imbue them self-discipline and respect. As a school, we hope to continually elevate our public exam results. Our focus remains on instilling the wisdom of Confucian philosophy in our students, equipping them with the knowledge and skills to pursue higher education and nurturing their personal integrity.

In closing, we extend our heartfelt gratitude to all the parents for their trust and support.

#### **School News**

### 4.1 Adjustments to Tuition Fees in 2024-2025 (To be confirmed by EDB)

The fees are subject to change upon Education Bureau's approval :

- HK\$5,670 annually in ten installments (HK\$567 monthly) for S.1 students
- HK\$5,670 annually in ten installments (HK\$567 monthly) for S.2 students
- HK\$5,670 annually in ten installments (HK\$567 monthly) for S.3 students
- HK\$5,670 annually in ten installments (HK\$567 monthly) for S.4 students
- HK\$5,670 annually in ten installments (HK\$567 monthly) for S.5 students
- HK\$5,670 annually in ten installments (HK\$567 monthly) for S.6 students
- The adjustments of tuition fees are subject to students' admission to our school for the year.
- The tuition fees from October 2024 to June 2025 should be settled via direct debit from banks. The transaction is scheduled for the first working day of each month. The Direct Debit Authorization Form should be completed and returned to the Class Teacher for handling.

# • For security reasons, starting from September 2024, parents are required to pay tuition by bank autopay or cheque.

#### 4.2 <u>PE Uniform Rules in School</u>

Students are prohibited from wearing PE uniforms on days without PE lessons. Students violating the rule may be demanded to return home to get changed before they are allowed to enter the school.
